

















#### How well does the Fund understand your organization's strategy and goals?









#### To what extent did the Fund exhibit respectful interaction during this grant?






## To what extent did the Fund exhibit compassion for those affected by your work during this grant?






#### How clearly has the Fund communicated its goals and strategy to you?




# How consistent was the information provided by different communication resources, both personal and written, that you used to learn about the Fund?


# **Top Predictors of Relationships**




#### How would you rate the effectiveness of the Fund's response to the following:





#### How well does the Fund understand your intended beneficiaries' needs?




## To what extent do the Fund's funding priorities reflect a deep understanding of your intended beneficiaries' needs?






## Are the efforts funded by this grant primarily meant to benefit historically disadvantaged groups?

## **Respondent Demographics**

## **Differences in Ratings by Respondent Demographics**

It is CEP's standard practice to analyze responses for differences by demographic characteristics.

There are no consistent, significant differences across respondent Gender Identity.

**Respondent Person of Color (US Grantees Only)**: Respondents who identify as people of color rate significantly lower than respondents who do not identify as people of color for the Fund's understanding of their socio-cultural work factors, intended beneficiaries' needs, organizational goals and strategy, and organizational challenges, as well as the extents to which they believe the Fund's priorities reflect their intended beneficiaries' needs and that the Fund is transparent about its anti-racism vision and goals.

They report experiencing more pressure to monitor their organizational priorities during the selection process.

**Respondent Intersectional Identities (US Grantees Only):** Grantees who identify as women of color rate significantly lower than other grantees for the Fund's impact on public policy and the Fund's understanding of their socio-cultural work factors, intended beneficiaries' needs, and organizational challenges. Though, they rate significantly higher for the Fund's demonstration of respectful interaction. They are significantly more likely to indicate receiving non-monetary support.



Note: Survey questions about respondents' demographics were recently modified or added to match best practices, and depict comparative data from 50-75 funders in the dataset. Demographic questions related to grantees' POC and racial/ethnic identity are only asked of respondents in the United States.

Survey language and response options for questions about race and ethnicity are guided by best practices shared by National Institutes of Health, Pew Research Center, Psi Chi Journal of Psychological Research, and the US Census Bureau.

Survey language and response options for questions about gender and LGBTQIA identity are guided by best practices shared by Funders For LGBTQ Issues, HRC Foundation's Welcoming Schools, and the Williams Institute of the University of California – Los Angeles School of Law.

Survey respondents are asked to share their gender identities in a check-all-that-apply question. Each chart has the option of showing the average ratings of respondents who selected only "man," only "woman," multiple gender identities, "non-binary," "gender non-conforming," "prefer to self-identify," and "prefer not to say" - as long as that response option had at least 10 respondents.















#### To what extent was the Fund's reporting process straightforward?



#### To what extent was the Fund's reporting process adaptable, if necessary, to fit your circumstances?




To what extent was the Fund's reporting process relevant, with questions and measures pertinent to the work funded by this grant?



#### Who was primarily responsible for carrying out the evaluation?





### **Dollar Return and Time Spent on Processes**















If you have ever requested support from the Fund to help strengthen your organization, how did you determine what specific support to ask for?





# If you have ever requested support from the Fund to help strengthen your organization, how did you determine what specific support to ask for? - By Subgroup



















Grantees were asked to provide any suggestions for how the Fund could improve. Of the 104 grantees that responded to the survey, 33 provided a total of 28 distinct suggestions. These suggestions were thematically categorized by CEP and grouped into the topics below.

#### The Fund's Strategy (25% N=7)

- Embed DEI Focus Throughout Strategy, Types of Organizations Funded, and Supports Provided (N = 5)
  - "An increased focus on intersectionality."
  - "Continue to grow its investment in diverse partners that have keep knowledge and relationships with underserved communities."
  - "Elevate the visibility of more people of color with policymakers, the press, and the health policy community writ large by sponsoring briefings, putting people on panels/recommending them as keynote speakers, opening up your networks, and paying grantees for their time."
  - "Support women of color leaders of nonprofits."
  - "Support a number of programs aimed at developing minority health policy researchers including efforts to attract more minority colleges students to be interested in these fields."
- Give Grantees More Opportunity to Inform Fund Strategy (N = 2)
  - "Create more accessible mechanisms and opportunities for current and also potential grantees to help vet, and suggest strategic priorities and interventions."
  - "I have really appreciated...when the Fund brought grantees with related projects together to....discuss...how Fund could invest strategically in th[eir shared priorities].... Would love to see that happen again."

#### Interactions and Communications (21% N=6)

- Improve Quality of Interactions, Including Through Greater Demonstration of Trust in Grantees (N = 3)
  - "Being even more open to suggestions from grantees."
  - "The Fund is consistently more difficult to work with than our other funders. Having worked with a number of individuals within the organization, the Fund staff are consistently heavy-handed in trying to influence the scope of a project grant and the outcome."
  - "Trust grantees to deliver."
- More Communications about Future Funding Opportunities (N = 2)
  - "More research idea exchange[s]...not just what the next grant might be about but how to strengthen and extend the current work."
  - "More specific guidance on funding opportunities to address Fund priorities. More consistent follow-up."
- Other Suggestions (N = 1)
  - "More organized communication, based on understanding of power dynamics (e.g., those in application stages do not want to have to follow up multiple times b/c don't want to hurt their chances of receiving funding, etc.)"

#### Grantmaking Characteristics (18% N=5)

- Provide General Operating Grants, Particularly Multi-Year General Operating Grants (N = 4)
  - "Funding general operational support with clear metrics for success."
  - "Give bigger, more unrestricted, multi year grants rather than project-specific, time-bound grants."
  - "Most funders prefer to fund specific projects. The real struggle for grantee organizations, however, is to obtain general funding. It is difficult to maintain the reputation that makes a grantee a good funding opportunity without support for basic operations."
  - "Multi-year grants for more reliable funding and a willingness to provide core support as well as project support."
- Other (N = 1)
  - "Many organizations working with equity iniatiatives are underfunded and underresourced.... Consistent funding would equalize the table."

#### Administrative Processes (11% N=3)

- Reduce Process Requirements and Streamline Processses (N = 2)
  - "Be slightly more sensitive to how many products and outcomes they request given the amount they fund. My work with the Fund has required much
    more in terms of products/outcomes compared to other grants for how much money is granted."
  - "Relative to other grantors, the Fund has a more bureaucratic process."
- Other (N = 1)
  - "The evaluation website is hard to navigate and the instructions could be simpler."

• Deepen Thought Leadership Role (N = 2)

- "Because the policy discussion around in our space in moving so quickly, increasing the speed in which the Fund brings new research to publication."

  - "Collaborating with other funders in areas where funding is in short supply."
